

# VISITOR SAFETY GUIDELINES

Please read the full list of rules and conditions on your access permit. Before applying for a permit or visiting one of our forests, please also read the following:

**In the event of an accident or fire dial 111**

## Hunting



- You are not permitted to carry firearms, weapons or go hunting without a hunting permit.
- If you are caught hunting without a permit you will be issued with a trespass notice.
- You must not use tracer bullets.

## Environmental



- You are not permitted to remove plants, forest products or any other materials.
- If you are caught removing material, you will be issued with a trespass notice.

## Dangers



- Lighting fires is not allowed, and you must take care to avoid accidentally starting a fire.
- Strong winds can uproot trees, break branches and dislodge pine cones so stay away from the forest in these conditions.
- Possum trapping and poisoning operations will be notified when you receive your permit but please look for signs and keep any pets under close control.
- Keep well away from any forest operations or equipment, even if not operating.
- Do not climb on any log stacks or piles.
- Be aware of other forest users who may be in vehicles.
- Forest roads may be rough and narrow and other people may be using them. Please always drive cautiously, with headlights on, and adhere to speed restrictions.

Note that overnight camping is **NOT** allowed in our forests
