HIGH CONSERVATION VALUE FOREST AREA

Protected Area: Office Creek Seepage – Berwick Cmpt 316, Maungatua Block

Reference: E405, N101

Regulatory Requirements:

Otago Regional Council - regionally significant wetlands list.

NES-PF.

This Wetland is in the process of being established as a Reserves Act covenant area. Covenant conditions will be attached when formalised.

Environmental Values:

- 1. Water and soil values Water and soil conservation, managing run off and essential for maintaining hydrological values.
- 2. Scenic values Patches of regenerating and/or advanced wetland.
- 3. Recreational values Walking, education.
- 4. Cultural/Historical values Kai Tahu have asked for preservation of this area.
- 5. Scientific and ecological values Patches of regenerating and/or advanced wetland, Dusky galaxias present in stream.

Management Objectives:

Protection of the stream and wetland to allow natural regeneration and enhancement of ecological values.

Management Guidelines:

- 1. When replanting, set back 10m from the wetland edge.
- 2. When harvesting, directionally fell trees away from the wetland. Where a tree accidentally falls into the protected area it must be removed before trimming or left (whatever is to cause the least damage).
- 3. Keep machinery at least 5m back from the wetland.
- 4. Avoid sedimentation into the wetland through use of sediment traps, cutouts on tracks, slash or vegetation for water filtering etc.
- 5. The Harvesting Plan shall be submitted to the Woodflow Manager and the EMS Coordinator for approval and in sufficient time for stakeholders to be consulted before harvesting commences.
- 6. Use of chemicals within this site is to be strictly controlled to exclude damage to indigenous vegetation and drift into the waterway.
- 7. Tracked and wheeled vehicles are not permitted within the protected area.
- 8. Remove wildings.
- 9. Do not modify the drainage patterns of this site.

Monitoring Requirements:

- 1. Monitor annually using the Wenita Forestry Natural Areas Assessment Form
- 2. Monitor for wildings annually and fell as required
